Why Kairos? Kairos (καιρός) is a Greek word meaning the right or opportune moment. In the New Testament kairos carries the meaning of an appointed time in the purpose of God.

Having recently completed a congregational visioning process, the Kairos 2040 committee and Session believe now is an opportune moment for Christ Presbyterian Church to refurbish our building and provide appropriate spaces for the ministry priorities God has shown us.
