

- 2) What does it mean to "belong to Jesus Christ?"
- 3) What are some purposes of spiritual gifts mentioned in v.11-15?
- 4) What did it mean then, and what does it mean today, to either be "ashamed of" or "not ashamed of" the gospel?
- 5) What are all the ways "the gospel" is defined throughout this passage?
- 6) "The one who is righteous will live by faith."
Think of 2 or 3 examples, from scripture or from those you know, who illustrate this statement. How and why?
- 7) What is the relationship between righteousness and faith? How would you define these 2 words?
